

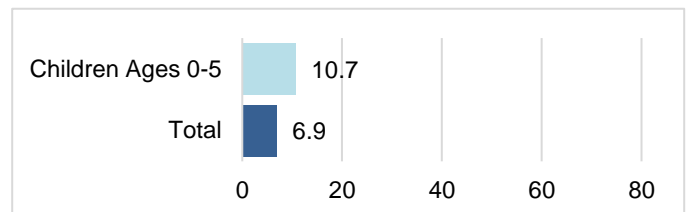

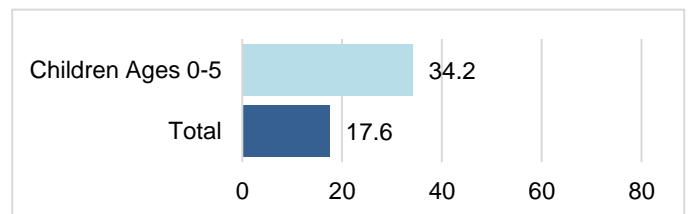

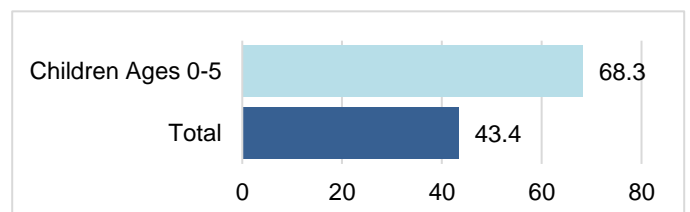
Percent in **Deep Poverty** (<50% Poverty Rate)

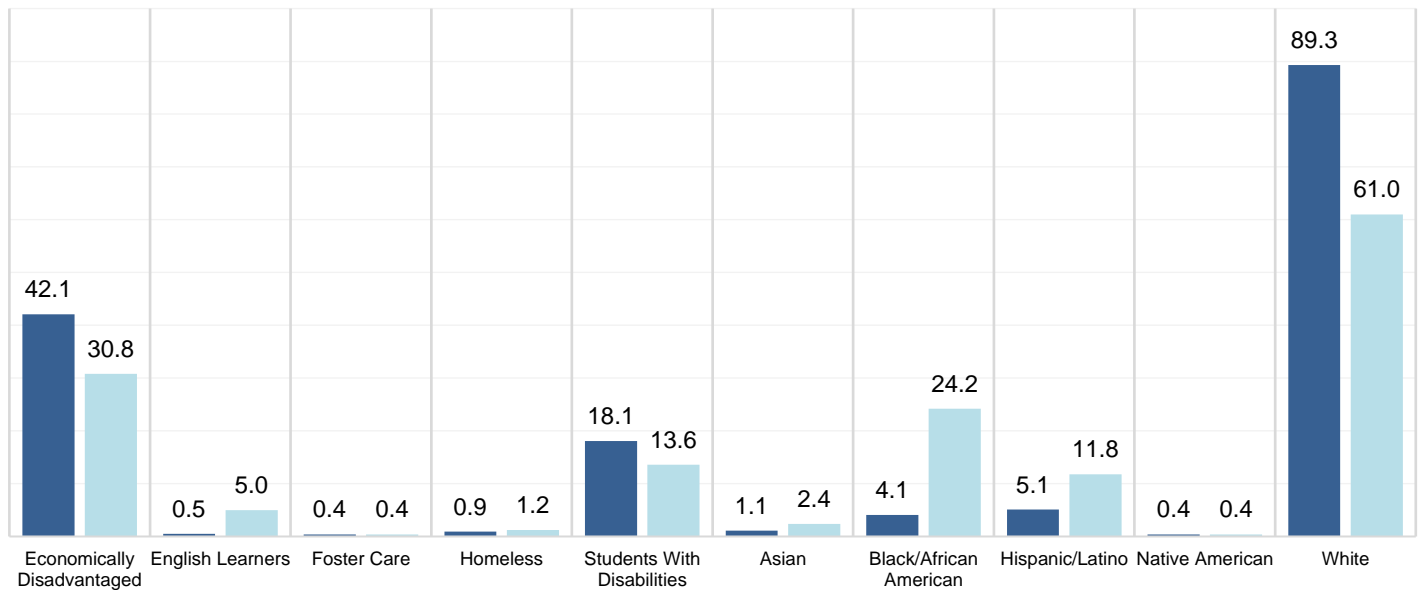

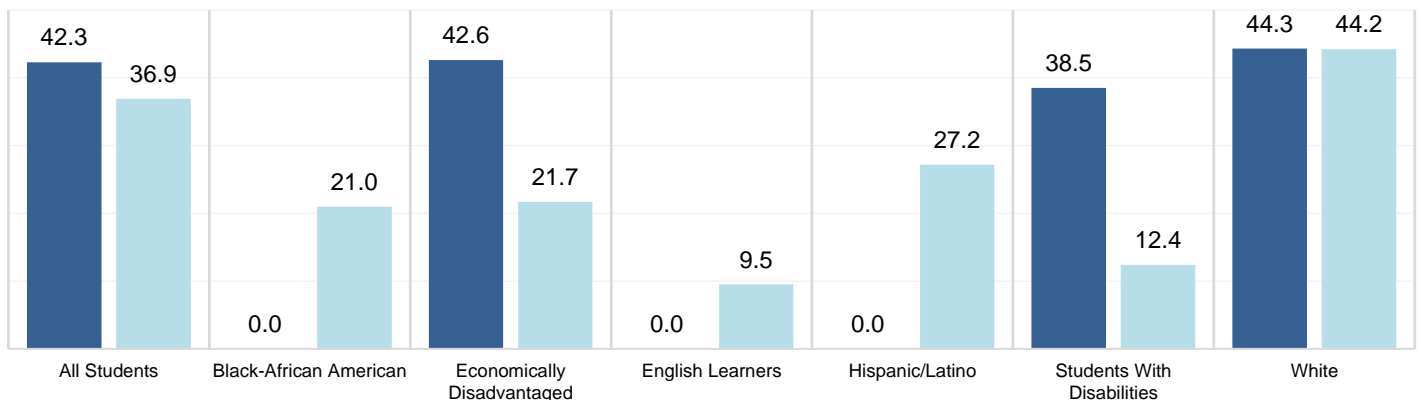
Percent PK-12 Enrollment by Student Group, SY20-21

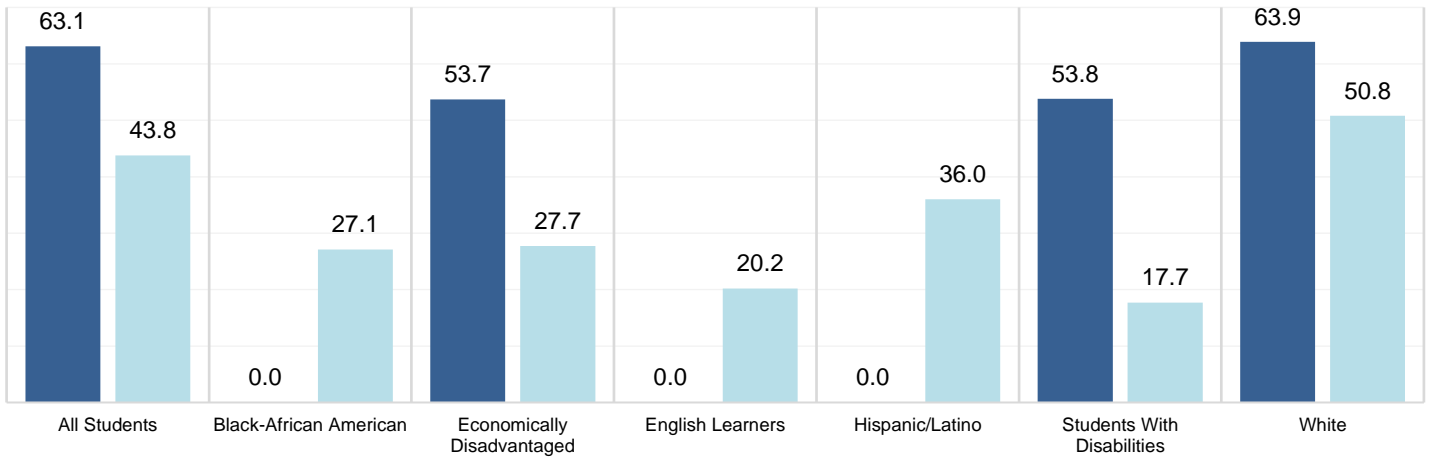

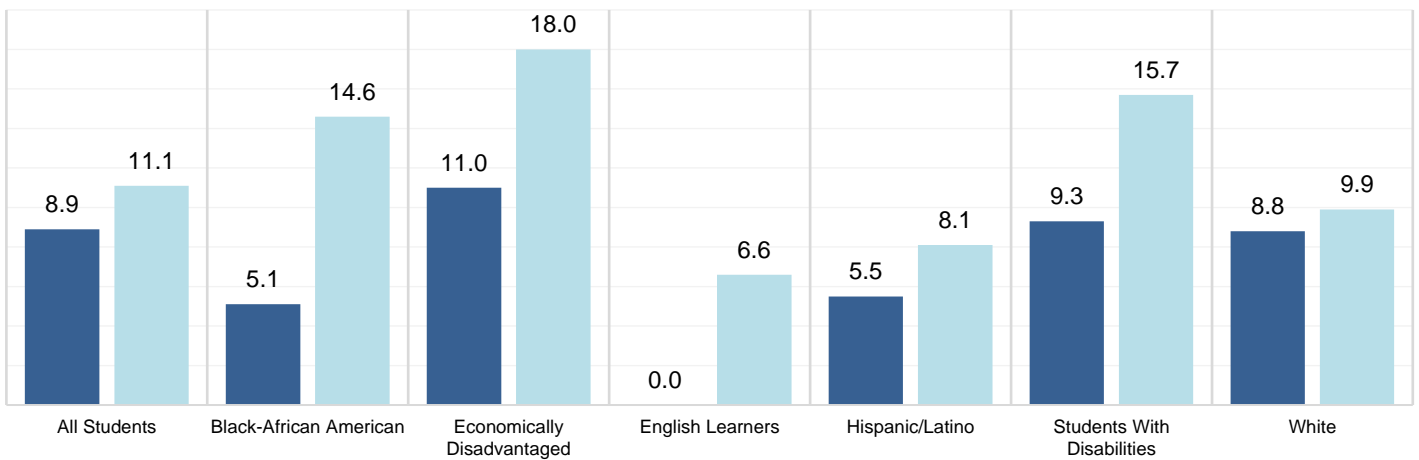

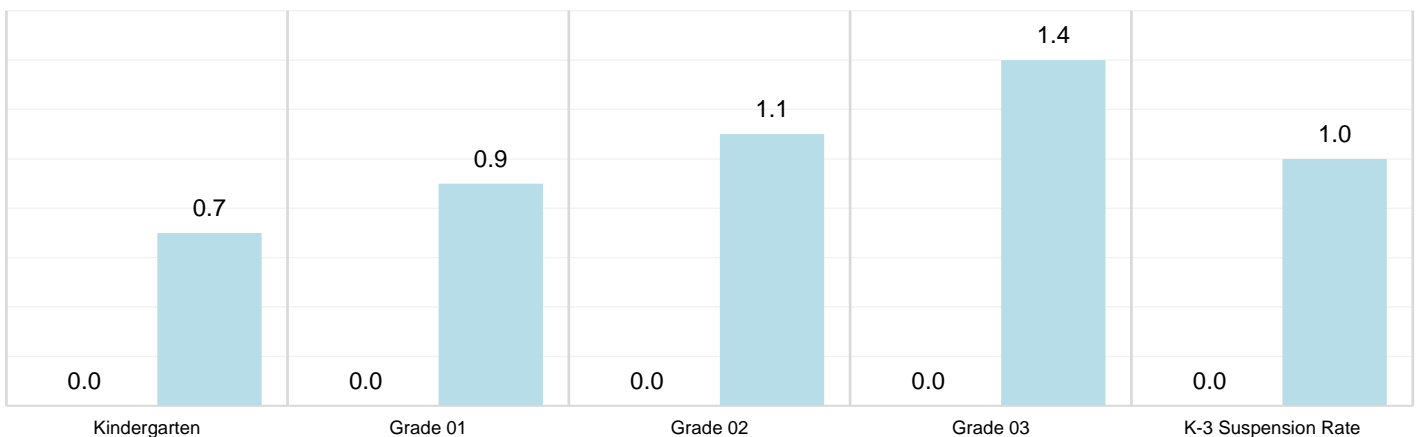
Percent Chronically Absent, Grades K-8, SY19-20

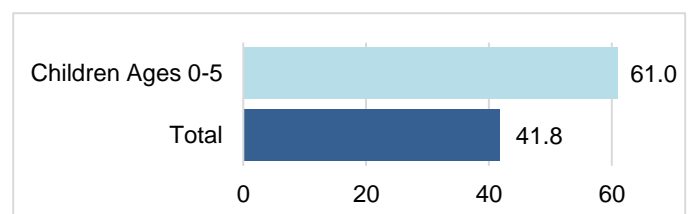

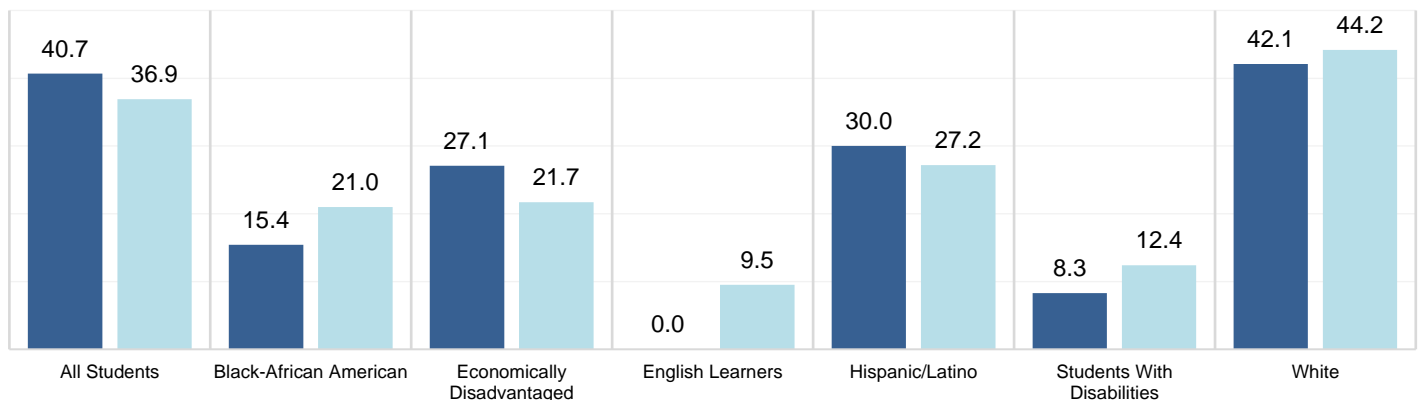
Percent PK-12 Enrollment by Student Group, SY20-21

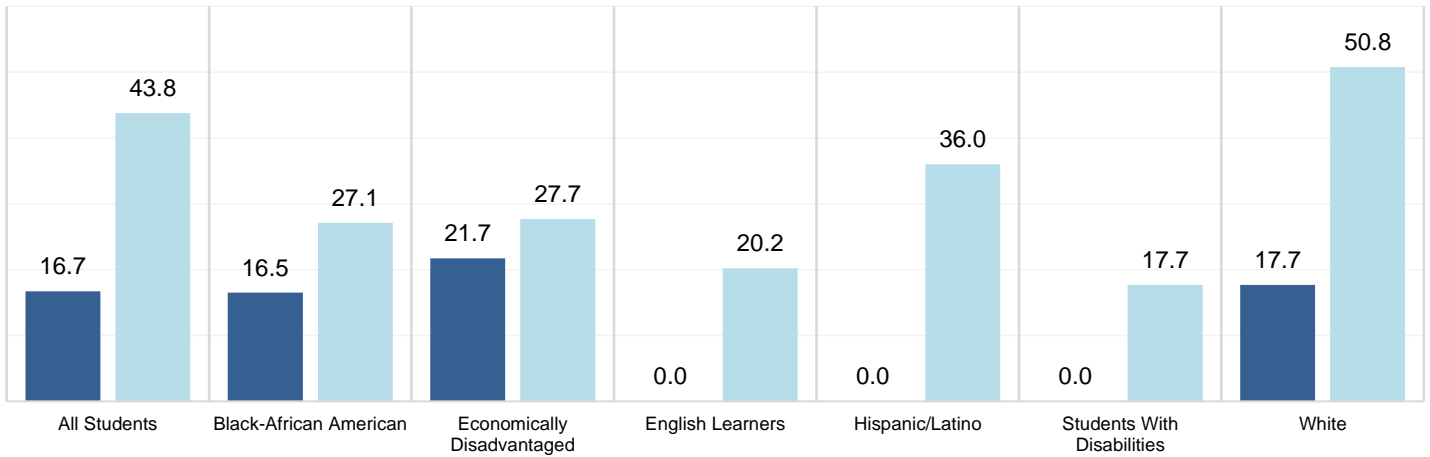

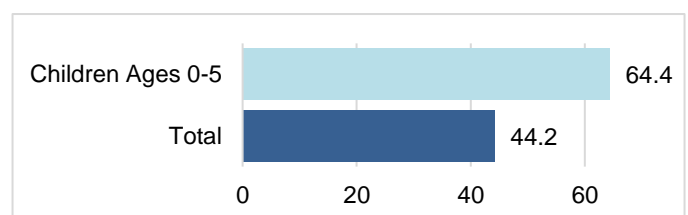

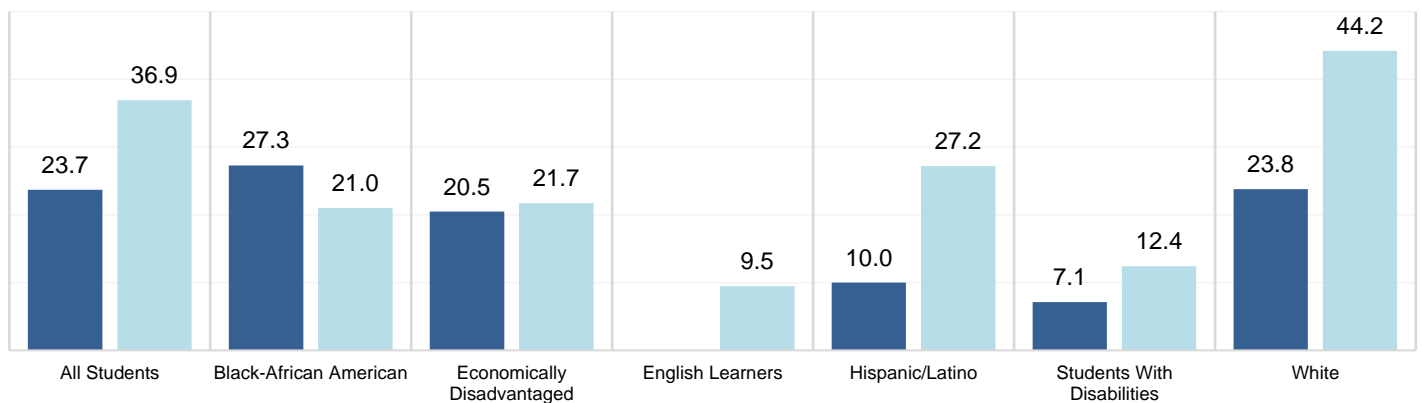
Percent PK-12 Enrollment by Student Group, SY20-21

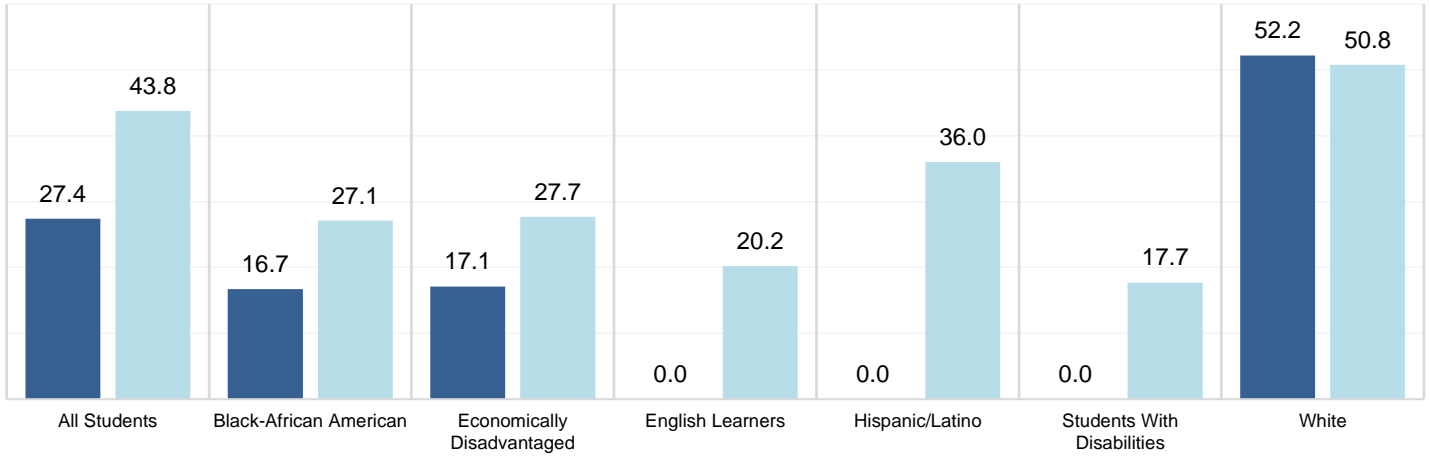

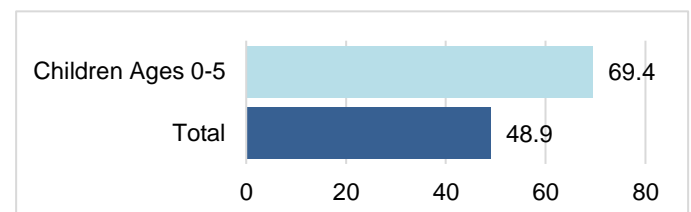

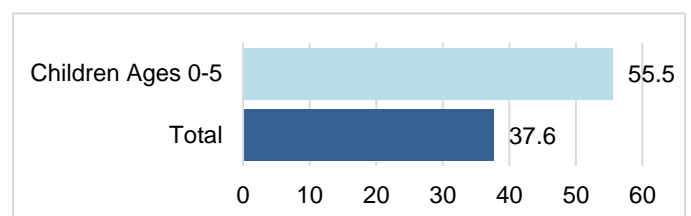

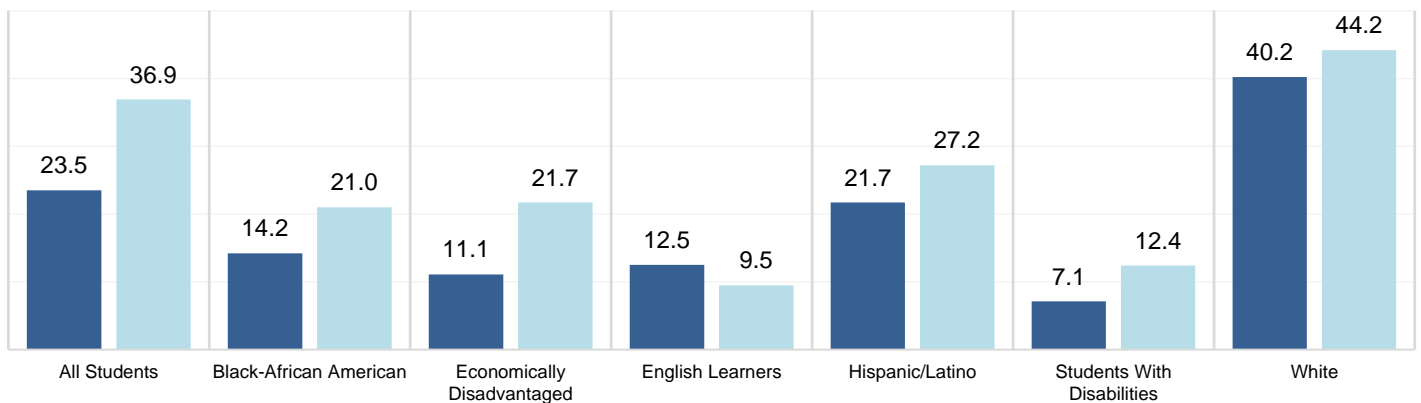
Percent PK-12 Enrollment by Student Group, SY20-21

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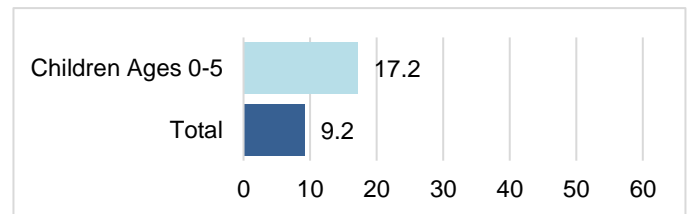

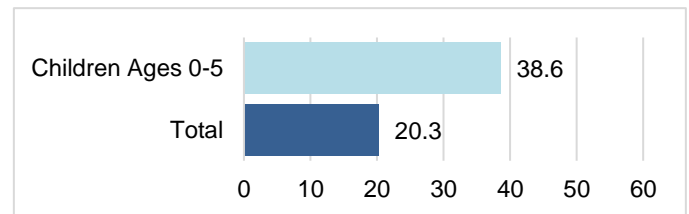

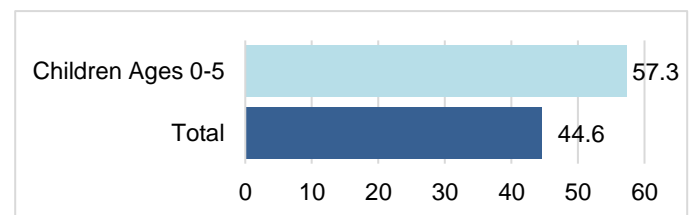
Percent in **Deep Poverty** (<50% Poverty Rate)

Percent **Low Income** (200% Poverty Rate or less)



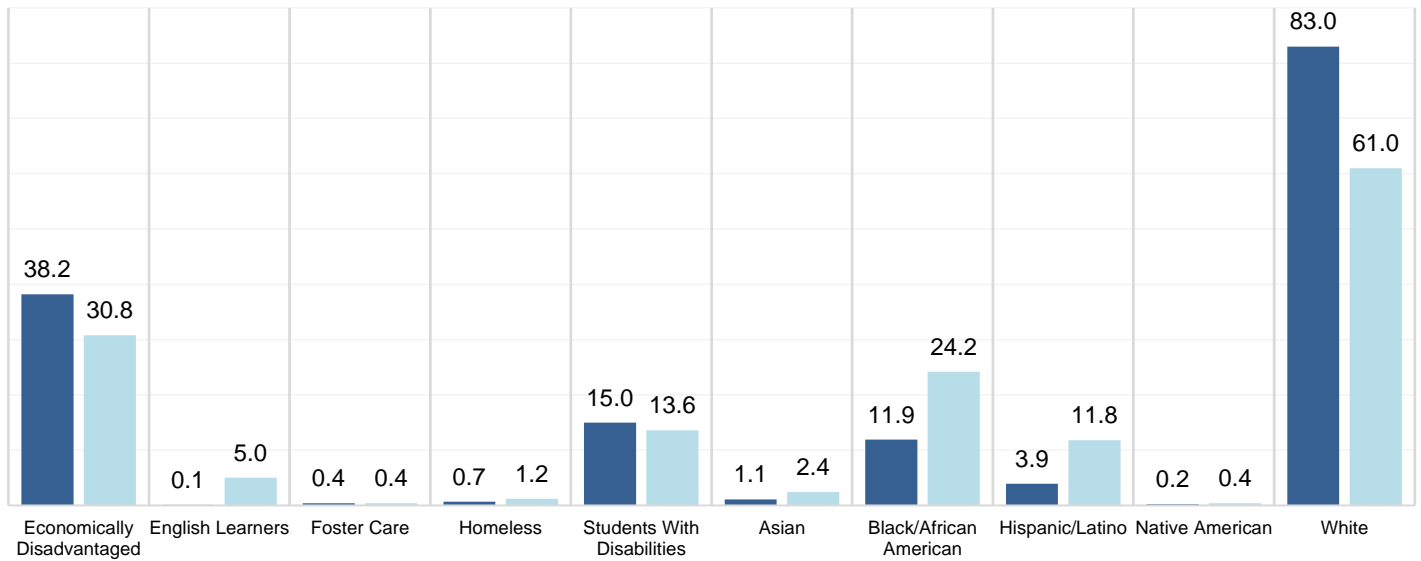

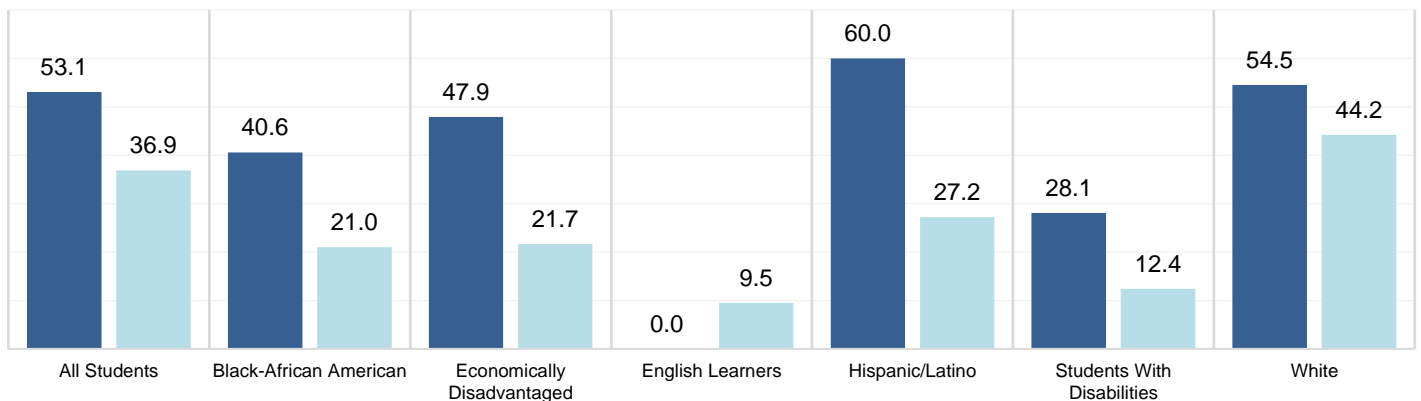
Percent PK-12 Enrollment by Student Group, SY20-21

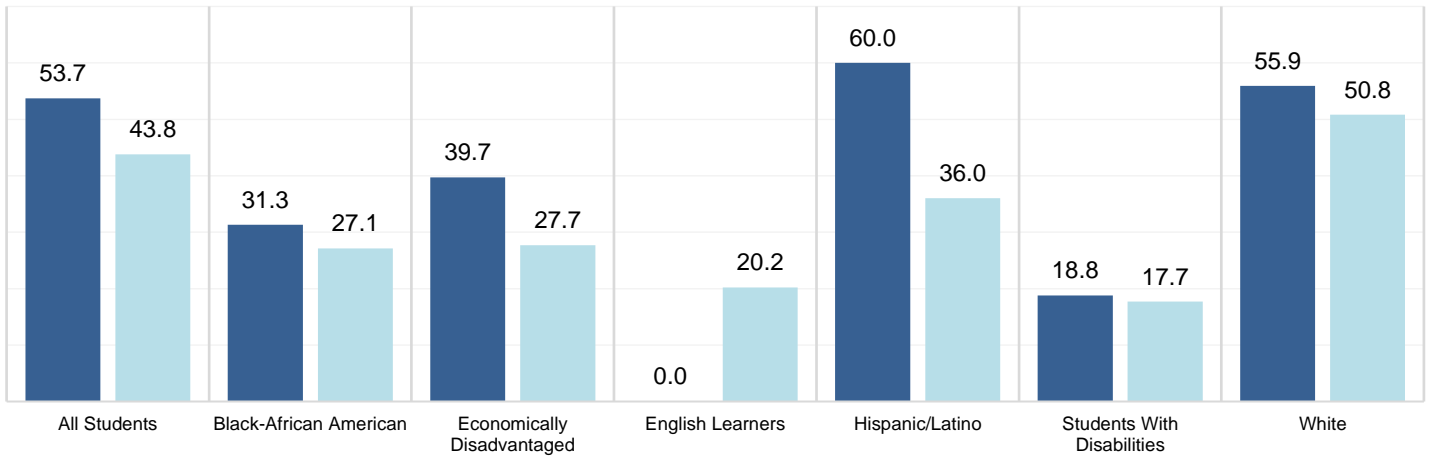
Grade 3 Reading On Track & Above, SY19-20

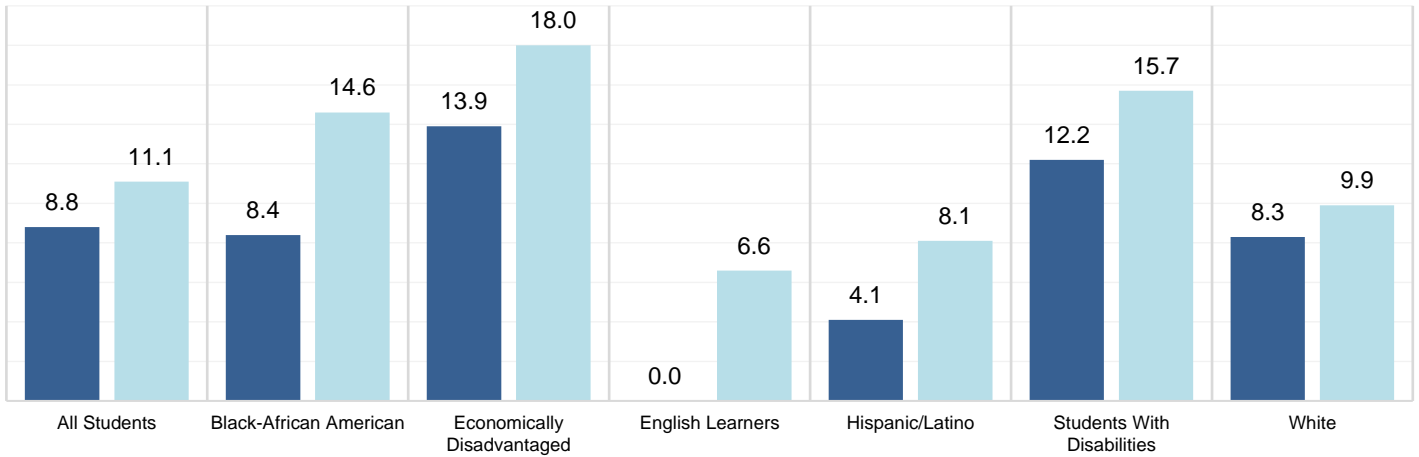
Grade 3 Math On Track & Above, SY19-20

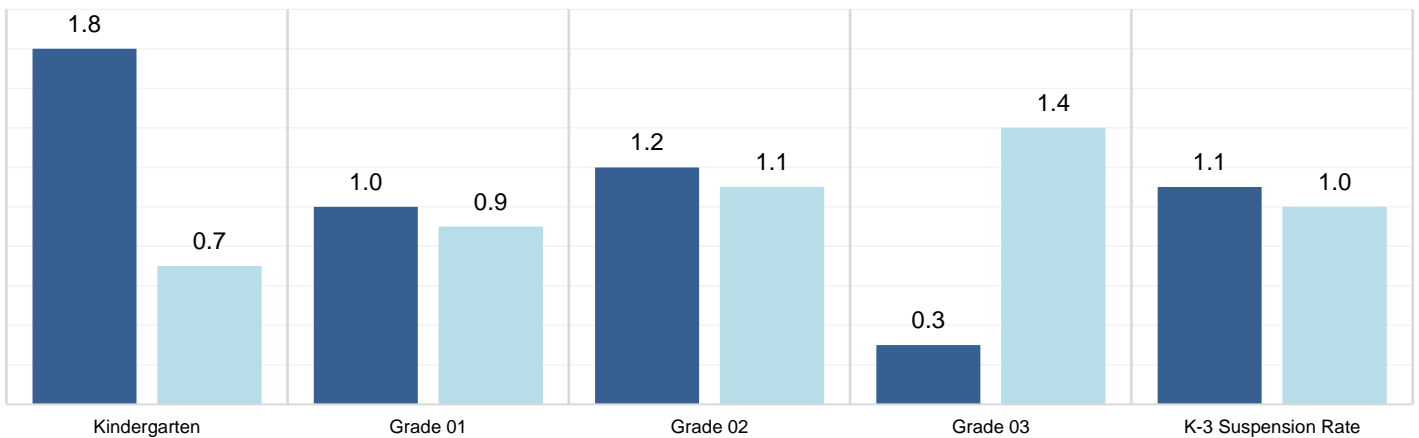
Percent Chronically Absent, Grades K-8, SY19-20
